VILLAGE UNCORKED POPS THIS SATURDAY AT WINTER PARK

Holiday Weekend Kicks Off With Winter Park's Popular Wine, Art, and Cheese Festival



WINTER PARK, Colo. – The Independence holiday weekend crackles at Winter Park Resort with the immensely popular Village Uncorked wine, art, and cheese festival taking place in The Village at Winter Park on Saturday, July 1 from 12- 4:00 p.m.

Glasses are \$30 at the door and guests are encouraged to pre-order the classes and wine glasses at www.winterparkresort.com to avoid lines.

The Village will also be transformed into an art gallery with live art demonstrations. There will be a variety of convenient 15-minute classes and seminars, covering everything from cheese making, to rosé wines, to wine and cheese pairings.
